Gender Stereotyping Workshop in Commemoration of International Men's Day

On 19<sup>th</sup> November 2024, the Education and Socio-Economic Research Institute (ESERI) of the University of Seychelles will host a workshop on gender stereotyping in the Seychelles context, in commemoration of International Men's Day. The workshop will be based on participants' responses to an online survey and follow-up discussions, incorporating previous gender studies from Seychelles and current theoretical models explaining gender structures both locally and internationally. The workshop content is relevant to workplace cultures across Seychelles and serves as an ideal tool for team building and professional development. Professor Mats Deutschmann from the University of Örebro, Sweden, who is also a Research Consultant for the University of Seychelles, will facilitate the workshop.

The event is part of UniSey's 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary activities and is aimed primarily at male participants from UniSey, along with local representatives of public and private entities. The programme begins at 10:00 am and concludes at 12:00 pm, and will be held at Theatre 2 on UniSey's Anse Royale Campus.
