Publication of Special Conference Issue of the Seychelles Research Journal on the Theme of Inclusive Education

The Education and Socio-Economic Research Institute (ESERI) of the University of Seychelles is pleased to announce the publication of a Special Conference Issue of the *Seychelles Research Journal* (SRJ, Volume 7), in celebration of its third anniversary.

This issue compiles research presented at the “Innovation for Inclusion” Conference, held in October 2024. Organised by ESERI with primary funding from the Swedish Research Council, the Conference was a collaborative effort between UniSey, the Seychelles Ministry of Education, the Seychelles Institute for Teacher Education (SITE), and the University of Örebro, Sweden. It brought together local and international researchers, educators, and policymakers to explore how education systems can adopt innovative approaches to expand access, promote equity, and ensure cultural relevance.

Reflecting this spirit, the special issue features contributions from both, local and international presenters, highlighting critical research on multilingual education, digitalisation in schools, inclusive pedagogy, and the role of policy in shaping equitable learning environments.
